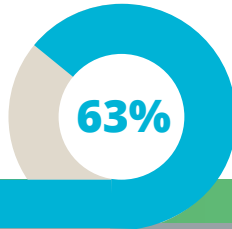


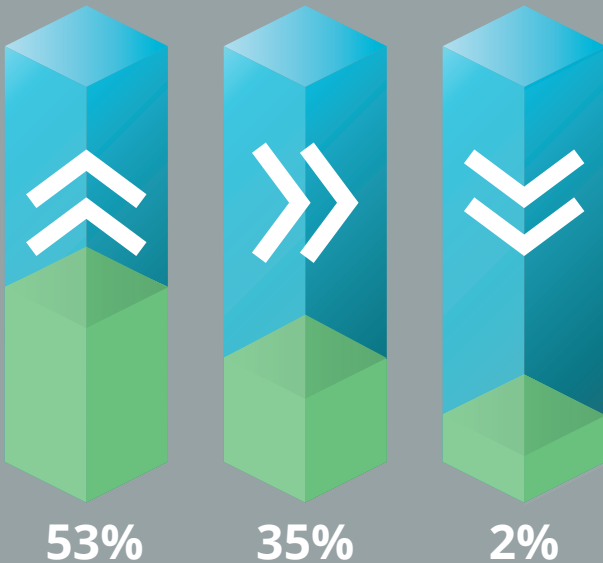
RECOVERY REINVENTED

63% of North Dakotans believe addiction is a DISEASE.



60%

60% of respondents have been impacted by addiction.



The majority of North Dakotans, **53%**, believe that problems with addiction are increasing in their communities, while only **2%** say that problems with addiction are decreasing. **35%** believe that problems with addiction are staying the same.

North Dakotans believe that **methamphetamine, alcohol, and opioids**

ARE THE **TOP 3** that *most negatively* affect their communities.



Respondents impacted by addiction were much more likely to:
support treatment facilities, in their neighborhood **64%**
sober living facilities in their neighborhood **68%**
equal opportunity for addiction related felons **65%**

North Dakota residents were polled July 28 - July 30, 2018 to determine attitudes towards recovery and addiction using a sample size of n=500. The poll has a margin of error of $\pm 4.4\%$.
